Build quality The material is of good quality, and the seams, where they are present, also match this. The fabric is loose enough to make it breathable and to allow flexibility, but not so loose that it is easy to catch. And I have to say - it feels pretty luxurious! Lyocell fibers are known to be extremely good, durable, very absorbent, naturally hypoallergenic, and antimicrobial (a lot of advantages, am I right?) For these reasons, Tencel is often mixed with cotton to produce a very strong, soft, and moisture-wicking set of sheets. But since these sheets are not mixed with any other material, sleeping gets to enjoy the pure Tencel in all its splendor. Now, when you are looking for new sheets, you will notice that two words continue to appear: percale and sateen. These terms refer to the fabric style used to create a set of sheets and each offers a distinct set of features. Sateen woven sheets (as we see here) usually provide a glossy glow and a satin-like hand look, while the percale sheets are usually clear and matte in appearance. These Brooklyn Bedding sheets are certainly true to the style of sateen fabric; feel silky-smooth, and provide an elegant streak. Sateen sheets also tend to be a little thicker and less breathable, and are not always well suited for sleepers that run hot. But these satin sheets sleep cold? Well, let's take a closer look! Each set is equipped with an upper sheet, two pillowcases and a mounted sheet, capable of housing mattresses up to 14 inches deep. That's why many brands of bedding design sheets fitted to have extra-deep pockets (15 inches or more) in order to accommodate everyone. So if you have a mattress that is 15 cm deep or larger, you might not be compatible with the dimensions of this bedding. But if these sheets match your mattress, you might be in charge of a treatment. This bedding feels very soothing against the skin, elegant drapes, and looks as silky as it feels. They don't feel surprisingly light, but the fabric itself is not super breathable. I like how easily they stretch on my body, and I wouldn't go so far as to call them heating, but I'd like to more air flowing through the fabric. Although, Tencel's ability to wick moisture made me feel fresh and dry. Finally, these sheets get high marks from me. I love sleeping on herbal bed sheets, and found that they be luxuriously soft and glossy. In my opinion, they would be perfect for spring and autumn, when the air is clear but not cold. Folks looking to sleep green on some silky sheets should definitely give these a try! For comparison, I tested this set on Brooklyn Signature Bed Linen Mattress (which has an 11-inch profile), and then on a mattress with a 15-inch profile. These fit the BB mattress like a glove, but the pockets of sheets mounted often have become untucked on the taller mattress. So if you have a mattress that is over 14 inches tall, I suggest you take the 30-day return period to see how well they fit. Price – I love that these sheets come in a range of sizes, including Split King. But ranging from \$139-\$219, depending on which if you get it, these beddings won't be in everyone's budget. No Cooling – True to a sateen fabric, breathability is not this set of strong suit sheet. If you're looking for a hot sleep set of sheets, you might want to look elsewhere.
